ANIMAL CARE ATTENDANT - FULL TIME

Position Description:

Reporting to the Team Lead of Animal Care & Enrichment, CHS Animal Care Attendants are responsible for providing exemplary care and comfort to all of our animals on a daily basis. The team also works collaboratively with all departments to achieve clean and sanitary conditions and satisfy the needs of all animals our care.

Duties:

- Maintain clean and sanitary conditions in all areas where animals are housed and provide humane, fair, and equal treatment of all animals in the care of CHS.
- Ensure that all equipment and supplies are neatly organized and put away at all times and that all work areas are kept neat and orderly.
- Daily cleaning, spot cleaning, and disinfecting of assigned kennel areas per cleaning guidelines and protocols.
- Provide proper food amounts and types, water, proper bedding, litter areas, hiding/perching areas, behavior enrichment, proper light, humidity and temperature, to all animals per the animal feeding and care guidelines.
- Observe animals for signs of disease, injury, illness, or behavioral problems and report concerns to appropriate department(s).
- Assist with the movement of animals through the shelter and maintain proper records including animal monitoring cards, computer records, and identification as required.
- Collaborate with all operational departments to ensure successful outcomes of animals.
- Support and participate in daily animal behaviour enrichment programs, documenting activities as required.
- In consultation with the Behaviour Counselors, work to implement training plans for dogs in care.
- Observe and document animal behaviour and provide feedback and consultation on best path forward.
- Other duties as assigned.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum high school diploma.
- CHS is a COVID-19 safe workplace. With limited exceptions, CHS requires all employment applicants provide proof of fully vaccinated status in accordance with current guidelines. CHS also complies with all in-force Alberta Health Services directives regarding COVID 19 safety.
- Minimum one-year experience of professional or volunteer experience working with animals required.
- Genuine concern for the welfare of all animals.
- Successful candidate will be required to provide a criminal record check at their own expense to be arranged by CHS.
- Ability to work as part of a team or independently as required.
- Flexibility to work overtime when required.
- Ability to communicate professionally and effectively, both verbally and in writing.
- Familiarity with Microsoft Office suite.
- Excellent organizational skills and the ability to manage a wide range of tasks and competing priorities in a fast-paced environment.

Physical Requirements:

- Physically capable of and comfortable handling a variety of species including but not limited to: cats, dogs, rabbits, birds, rodents, and reptiles.
- Capable of lifting up to 50 lbs.
- Performing repetitive motions of reaching, squatting, bending, pulling.
