Commitment

- Provide positive interaction, affection, socialization and exercise for animals in the adoptions area to help increase their adoptability and to decrease their stress levels as they wait for the new forever homes

Rabbits 101

Requirements

- Attend a group interview
- Complete Police Information Check with vulnerable sector search. For youth, this can be done in person at any Calgary Police Service or RCMP Detachment. These checks can take several weeks to come back after you have submitted them so make sure to give it enough time. Please note there is a \$15 fee associated with this.
- Minimum age requirement 14 years old
 - Must be 15+ to assist Grade 7-9 campers
- Previous animal experience and knowledge is considered an asset
- Parents or guardian must sign Agreement & Release form
- Can be trusted to work independently and with minimal supervision and adhere to confidentiality policy.
- Ability to maintain a high level of professionalism and act as an ambassador for the Calgary Humane Society.
- Ability to take and follow directions.
- Ability to interact with the public in a friendly and professional manner.
- Have an appreciation and respect for animals and the values of CHS.
- Previous experience gained in Youth Ambassador Club or equivalent volunteer experience with children considered an asset
- Must be able to transport yourself to and from the shelter
