Term Position from June 20th to August 26th 2022 as follows;

- Monday to Friday | 37.5 hours per week
- Training: June 20th 24th
- Camps: July 4th August 26th

Camp is a place where kids connect with animals. Our goal is to provide an opportunity for children to interact and learn about the animals that share our world. Through our camps, children will have enriching experiences filled with hands-on animal encounters, fun activities, and crafts. As they have fun, campers learn respect, compassion, and how to provide a lifetime of care for animals.

Duties:

- Lead summer day-camp groups for children ranging from grades one to nine
- Prepare and conduct Humane Education activities and presentations teaching children about the interconnectedness of animals, people, and our environment
- Facilitate visits and liaise with special guest speakers
- Teach and model positive animal interactions, responsible pet ownership, and respect for all living things
- Organize and prepare educational materials
- Work with the Summer Camp Volunteers to ensure supervision of campers
- Assist the Humane Education & Outreach Facilitators as required
