

Who Came to Visit?

In this activity, you will have to figure out what animals left the tracks you see below, and what type of track pattern they left.

There are 4 types of track patterns:

1. **Zig-Zaggers:** usually have long legs. Their back print lands on or next to the front print.

Examples: Elk, deer, moose, dogs that are walking, coyote, humans



2. **Leapers & Hoppers:** have bigger back legs than front legs. Front feet land first, then back feet land in front.

Examples: rabbits, hares, squirrels, voles



3. **Bounders:** Have long bodies and all legs are the same size

Examples: weasels, ferrets



4. **Waddlers:** usually slow and drag their bellies/tails when they walk. They have short legs.

Examples: beaver, porcupine, skunk
