

FAQ

- **How does the bottle drive, clothing drive and E Waste drive work?**

Drop off your recyclable items to help the animals on **Saturday September 17 between 10 am and 3 pm** is quick and easy:

1. Pull up to our parking lot, right here at **Calgary Humane Society 4455 110 Ave SE** on **Saturday September 17 between 10 am and 3 pm**
2. Pop your trunk open
3. Our volunteers will remove the recyclables from the vehicle
4. We will be accepting cash, debit, credit card donations at the event – any donation above \$10.00 will receive a tax receipt.
5. Enjoy the rest of your Saturday or come inside to check out our new facility!

- **What will you accept?**

Bottles, cans, refundable beverage containers. [“Items accepted at Bottle Drive”](#)

Clothing, purses, shoes and belts. [“Items accepted at Clothing Drive”](#)

Old Electronics. [“Items accepted at E-Waste Drive”](#)

We accept blankets, sheets and towels – cleaned and bagged for Shelter Use – these will need to be bagged separately from the clothes.

- **Can I drop off recyclable items on a date other than September 17?**

Only bottles, cans, refundable beverage containers you can donated prior to the event by contacting Trail Bottle Depot directly:

1. Text your Name, Address and Email to Trail Bottle Depot at 403-991-2745 **Include: “Bottle Drive CHS – Sep 17”**
2. They will confirm your location and schedule a pickup time.
3. They will arrive at the scheduled time to grab your containers.
4. The containers will be brought to the depot for counting.
5. Once the count is completed, the refund for 100% of your return will be E-transferred to Calgary Humane Society.

Clothing and E-Waste items will be collected **only** on September 17 between 10 am and 3 pm. Due to space constraints, we do not have the capacity to receive the items before or after.

- **Can I leave the articles in another place?**

For this event, we will only be hosting the collection drive at our Shelter 4455 110 AV SE Calgary, AB T2C 2T7.

We hope to have additional drives throughout the city in the future.

- **How should I pack the items I will donate?**

Please pack your donations in recyclable plastic bags.

- **Is this Tax Receiptable?**

The donations of recyclable items will not be tax receiptable at this event.
For future donations – Skip the Depot offers pick-up and tax receipt.

- **Can I do other donations during the event?**

We will be accepting cash, debit, credit card donations at the event – any donation above \$10.00 will receive a tax receipt.

We accept blankets, sheets and towels – cleaned and bagged for Shelter Use – these will need to be bagged separately from the clothes.
