

APPENDIX "B" - ROLE DESCRIPTION

VOLUNTEER POSITION TITLE: BEHAVIOUR OUTREACH ASSISTANT

Commitment

For most roles, you will be asked to commit to a minimum of six months of service with a weekly commitment of two to three hours

Volunteers being considered for this role must be able to attend 2 buddy shifts with an experienced volunteer

Responsibilities

Behaviour Outreach Assistant plays a very important role in supporting the CHS Behaviour Outreach Team by:

- Review behaviour help line voice messages and emails with Outreach Facilitator
- Respond to behavioural emails using information from external resources and CHS website including behavioural handouts.
- Answer voice messages guiding callers to website resources, including private consultations, classes and behavioural handouts.
- Other administrative tasks as assigned e.g. welcome emails for dog classes
- Addressing clients' concerns with a non-judgmental, professional approach
- Adhering to CHS confidentiality policy while performing all duties

Qualifications

- Basic knowledge of animal behaviour including positive reinforcement and fear free training considered an asset
- Comfortable with making a significant number of phone calls

- Good at problem solving
- Self-directed, ability to work as part of a team or independently as required
- Great interpersonal skills, comfortable speaking with clients in a friendly and professional manner
- Demonstrates compassion and empathy during emotional telephone calls
- Have an appreciation and respect for animals and the values of CHS
- Punctual and reliable
- Basic computer knowledge, familiar with Microsoft Outlook and Office programs
- Previous customer service experience considered an asset
