Since 1922, Calgary Humane Society has been a refuge for animals in need. With about 4,000 animals arriving at the shelter each year our services are essential to giving every animal a happy, loving home.

Calgary Humane Society was the first animal welfare organization in Calgary and is one of the few open admission shelters in North America. This simply means that every animal is welcome at Calgary Humane Society.

For over 100 years, champions, like you, have been making this critical work possible. Thanks to you, homeless animals find a home. Abused animals get help. Animals stay happy and healthy in loving homes.

## What We Do

Calgary Humane Society is more than a shelter. We offer a wide variety of programming to support animals and their human families including:

- Protection for animals in unsafe situations and investigations of reports of animal cruelty
- Emergency Boarding for animals whose families are temporarily unable to care for them
- Pet Safekeeping for animals whose families are fleeing domestic violence
- Training classes and behaviour support for animals at the shelter and in the community
- Youth education programs to teach young people to respect animals
- Pet Food Bank for animals whose families need a little help providing for them
- Seniors Programs for seniors who need a little help caring for their beloved animal

# Tips and Tricks

**Fundraising can seem daunting at first, but it makes a huge impact in the lives of animals in need. During your fundraising efforts, just remember the incredible difference you are making!**

Here are a few tips and tricks to help you meet your goals:

## **Set a Goal**

Your goal is your finish line. Setting a goal is the first step. It will give structure to your fundraiser and build excitement among your supports.

## **Personalize Your Fundraising Page**

Add your own text and pictures. Remember, your donors might be interested in the cause, but they are definitely interested in supporting something you're passionate about. Be sure to tell them "why" it matters to YOU!

## **Get the Ball Rolling**

People can be nervous about being the first to donate. You can get your fundraiser off to a great start by making the first donation yourself. This lets everyone know you are serious about supporting this incredible cause.

## **Start with Those Closest to You**

## A Word About Tax Receipt Guidelines

Calgary Humane Society is honored to be your charity of choice. We are happy to issue a tax receipt in accordance to CRA regulations. Tax receipts will be automatically issued to donations of \$20 and over, unless contacted. This section outlines some guidelines governing receipting.

Tax receipts can only be issued if a donation is made without a personal advantage being received. This means that tax receipts can only be issued to those who have not received a product or benefit in return for their donation.

A tax receipt can only be issued in the name of the true donor so please be sure to specify who the gift is from. Event organizers cannot claim all event donations for themselves if others have donated to the cause as well. If a donor would like a tax receipt, use the attached donation form to collect their information.
