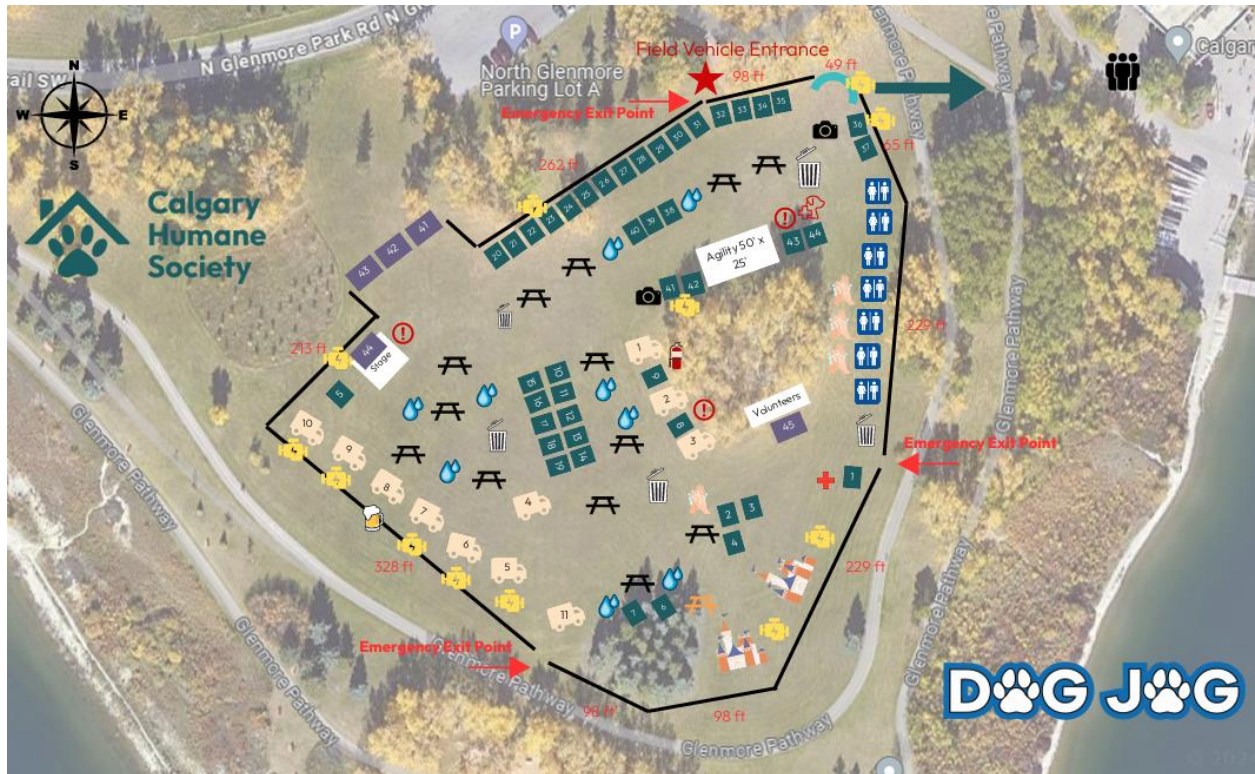
Changes in coverage	Please come with a willingness to be flexible, you may be reassigned.
